gives grace to the humble.*

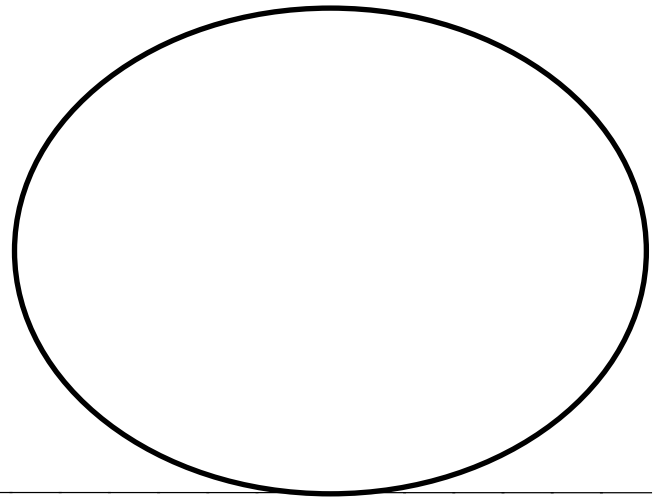

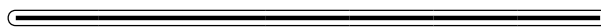
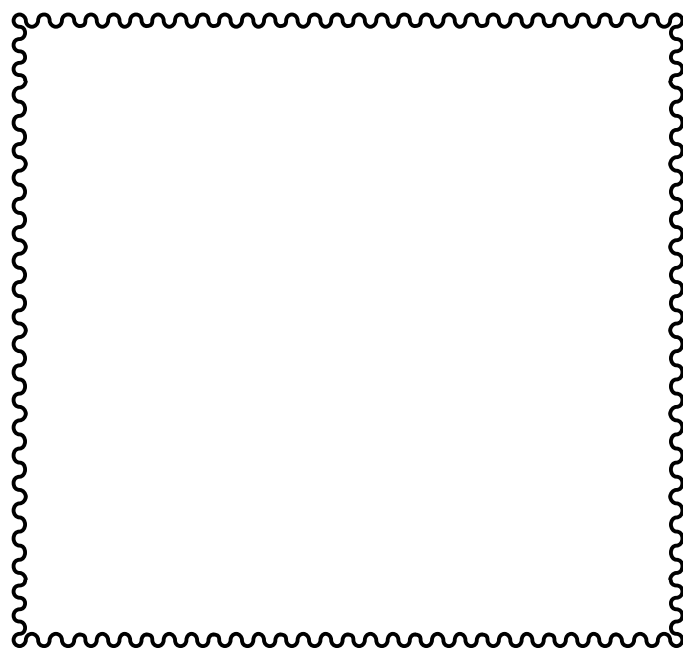
# Orderliness

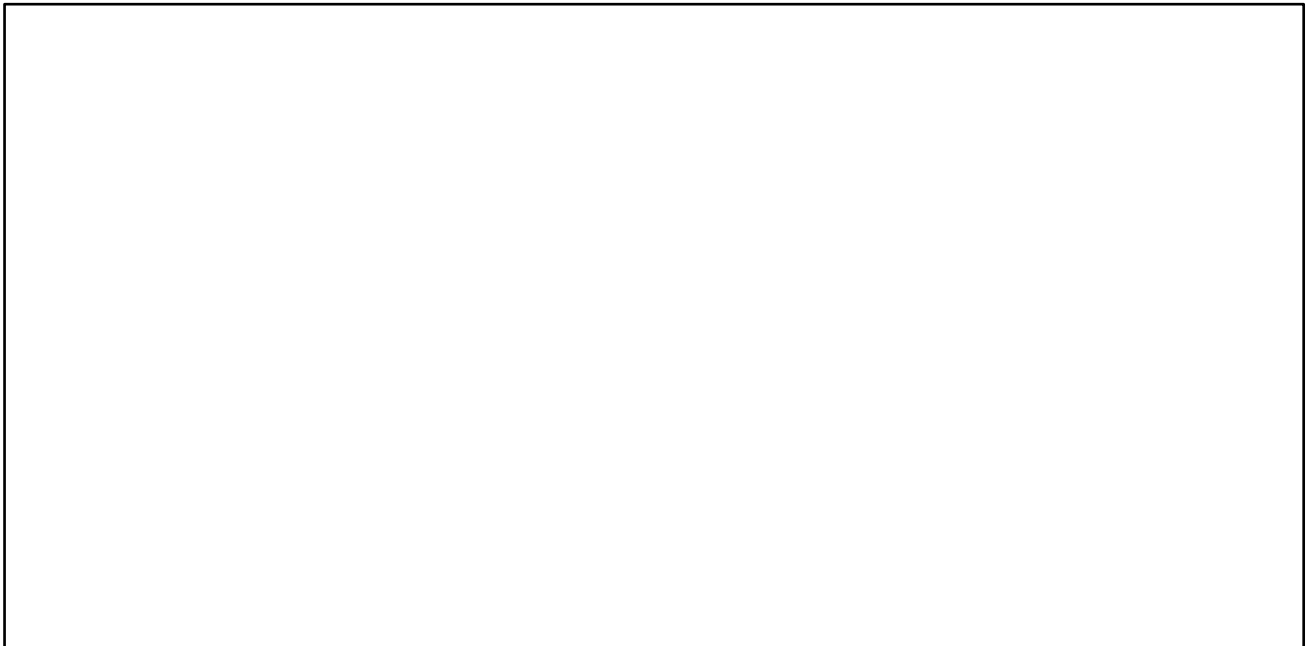
# Patience

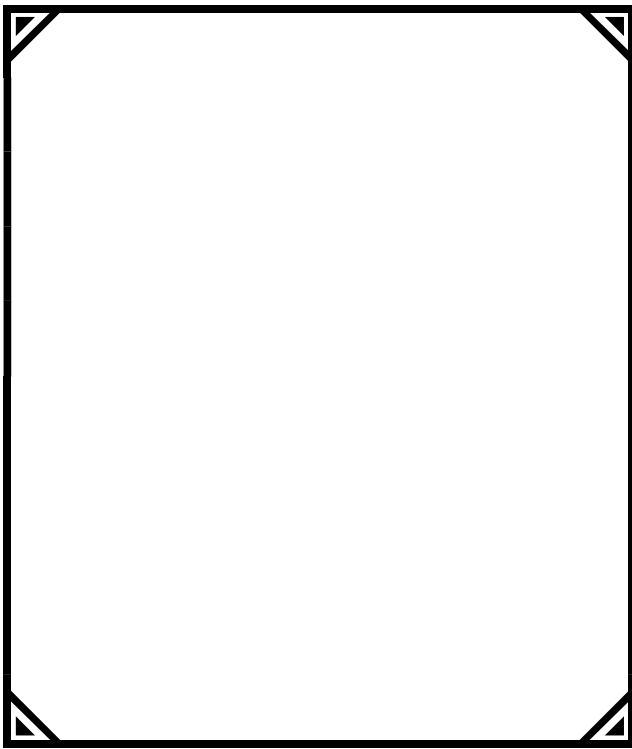


# Sensitivity vs. Callousness

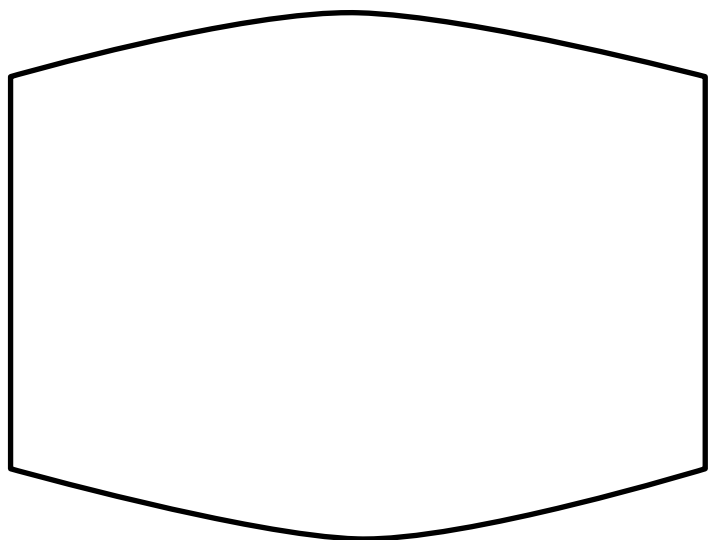
# Thoroughness

*The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and the knowledge of the Holy One is insight. Proverbs 9:10*



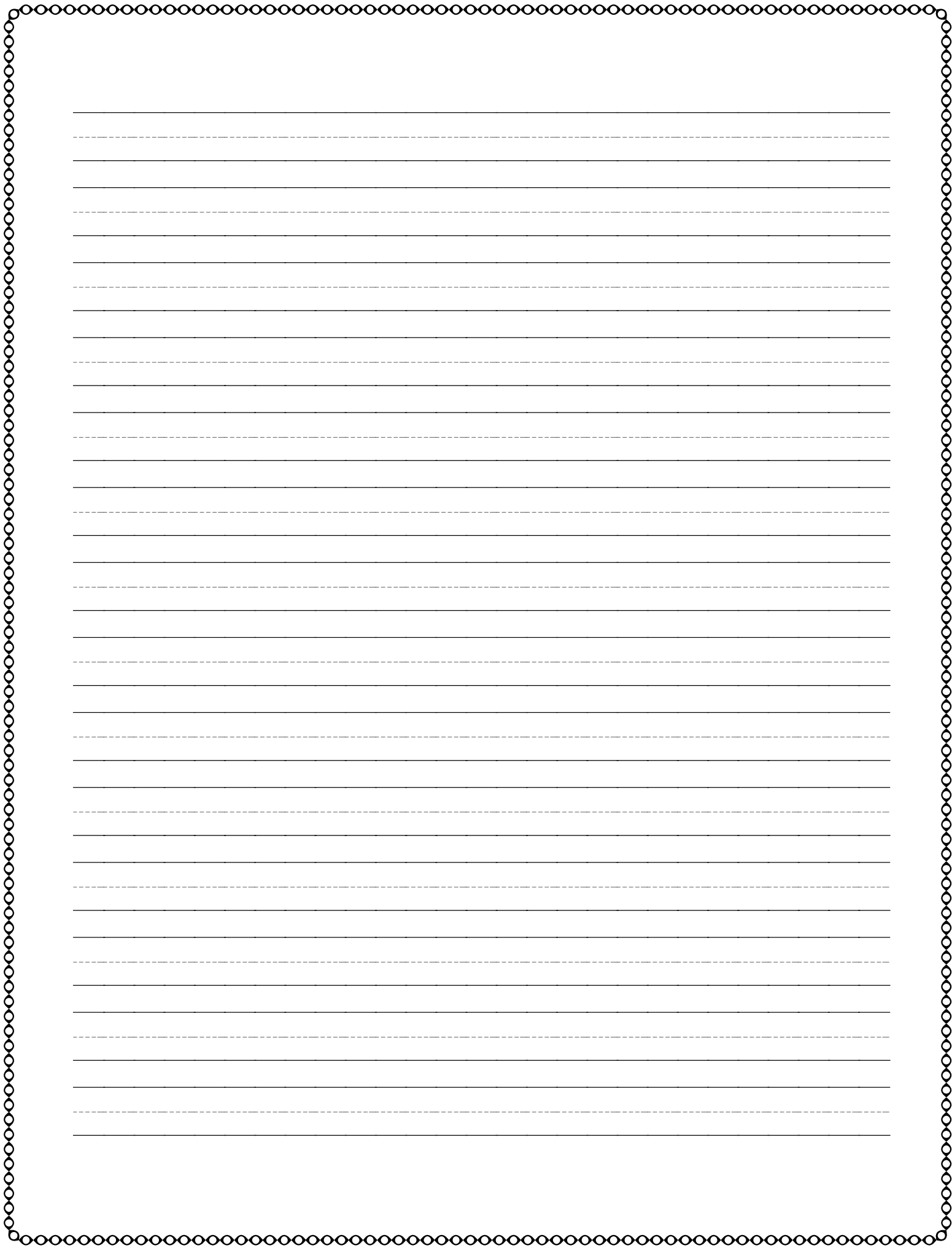

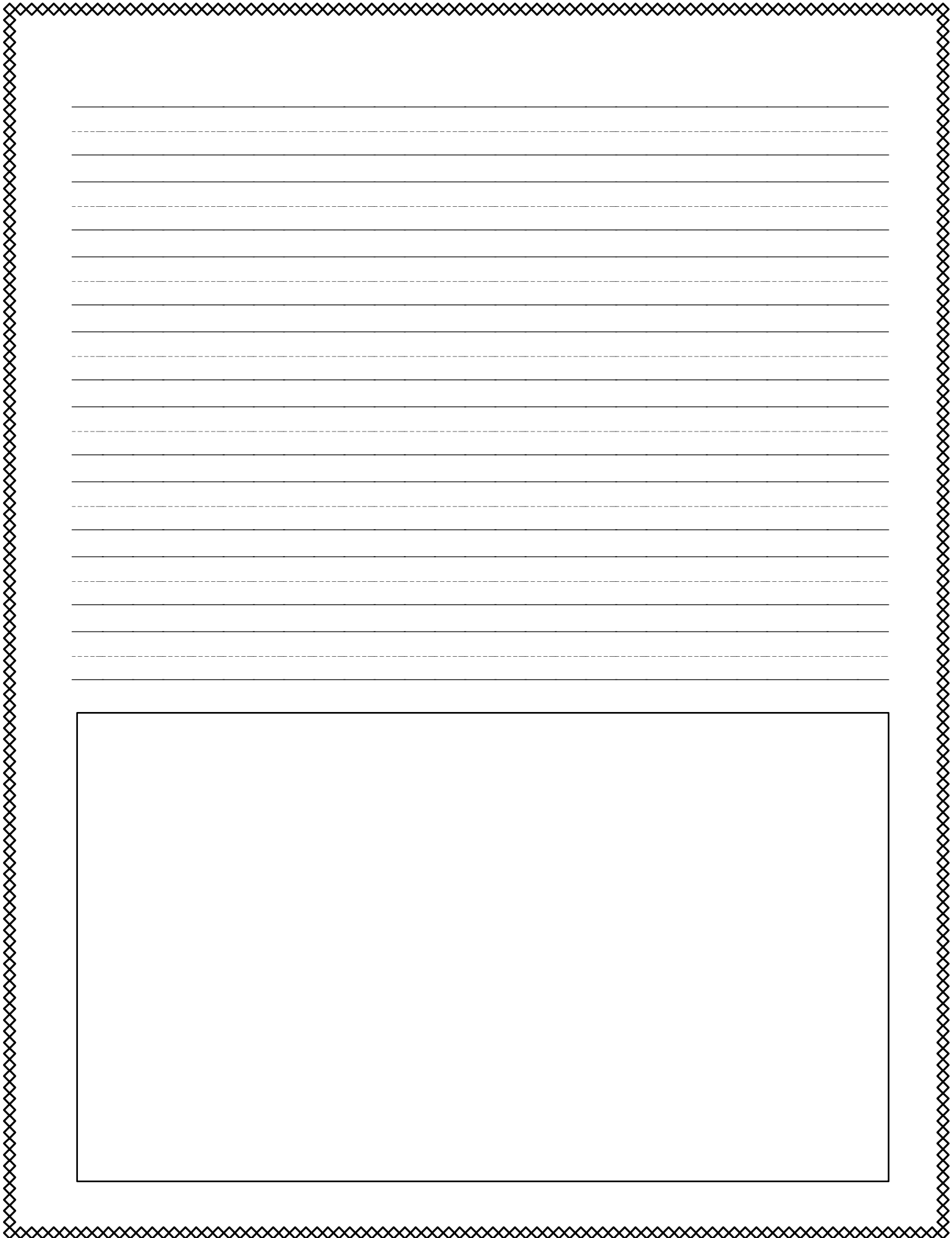
