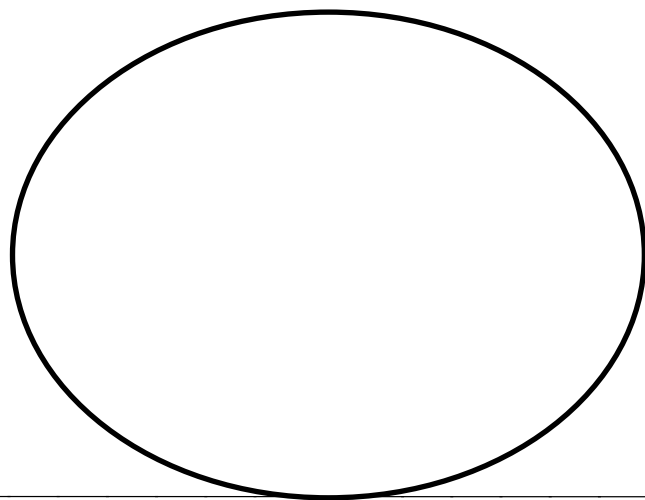

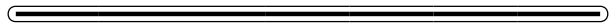
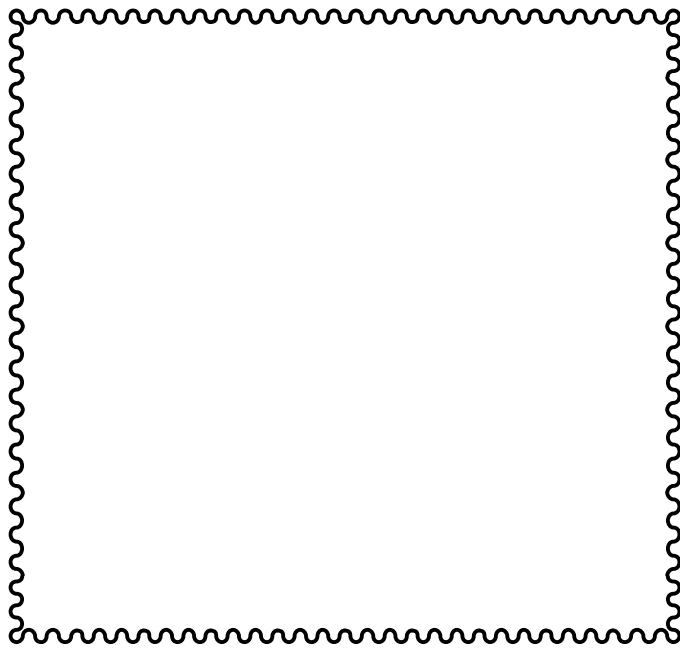
# Orderliness

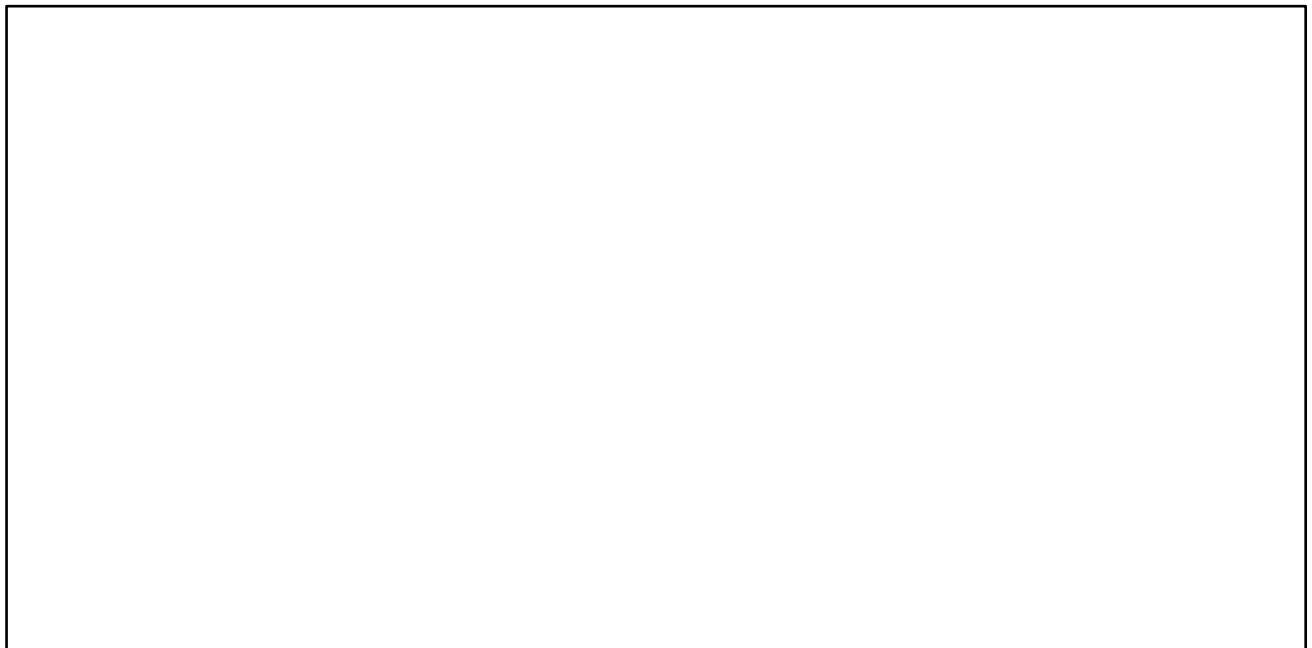
# Patience

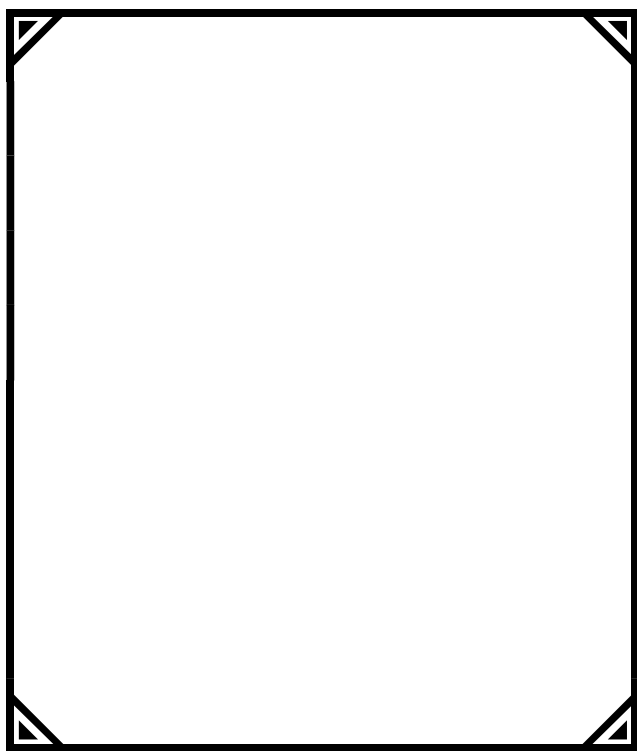
# Sensitivity

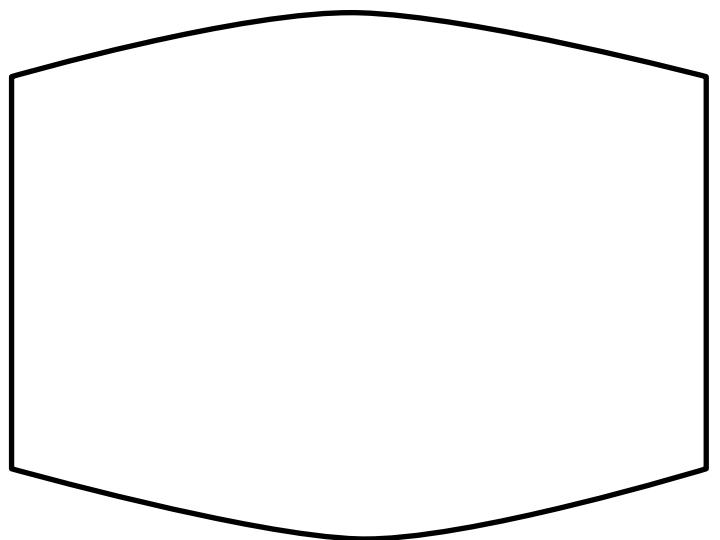
# Thoroughness

## vs. Natural Inclinations

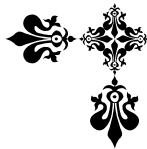
Seeing and responding to life situations from God's frame of reference

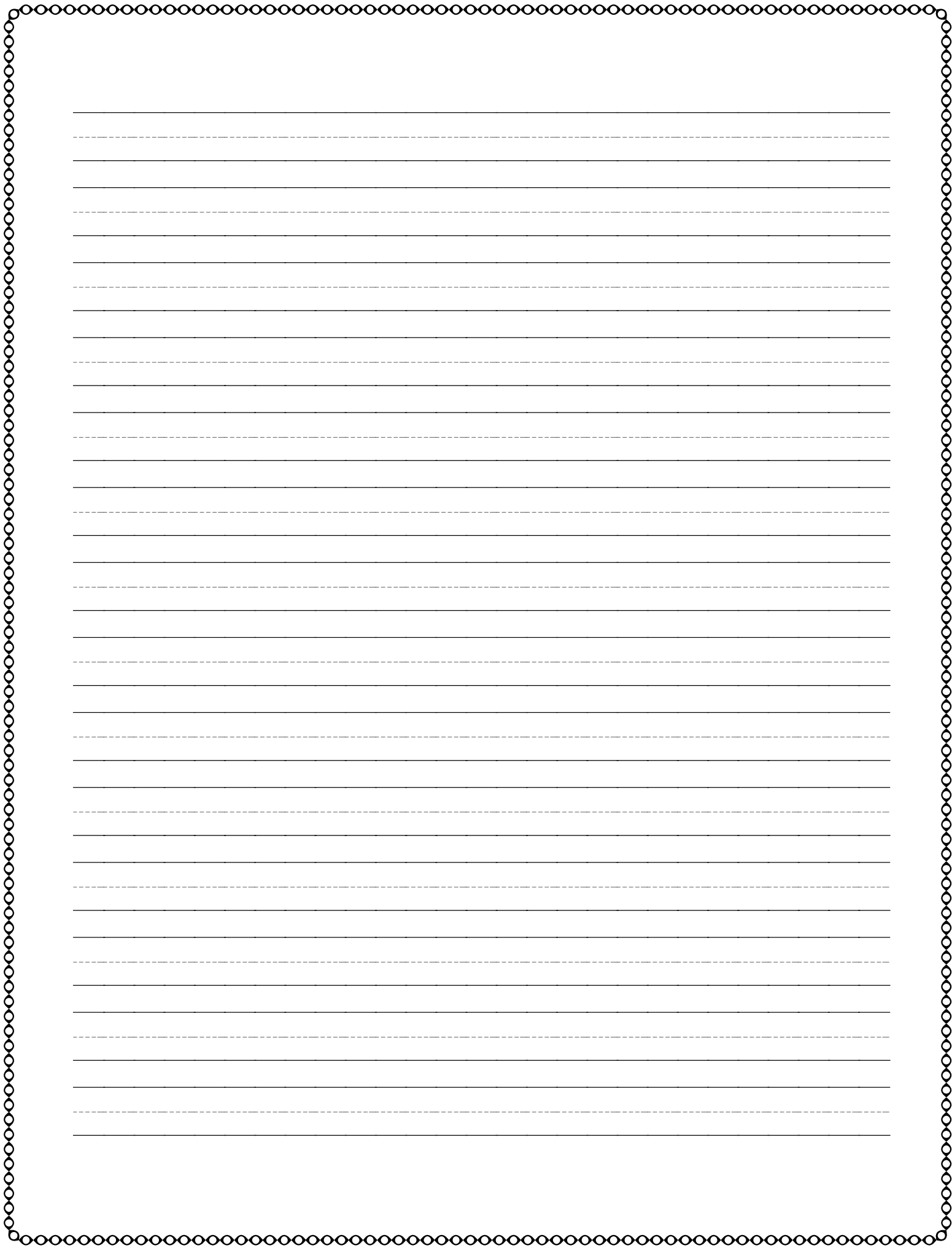

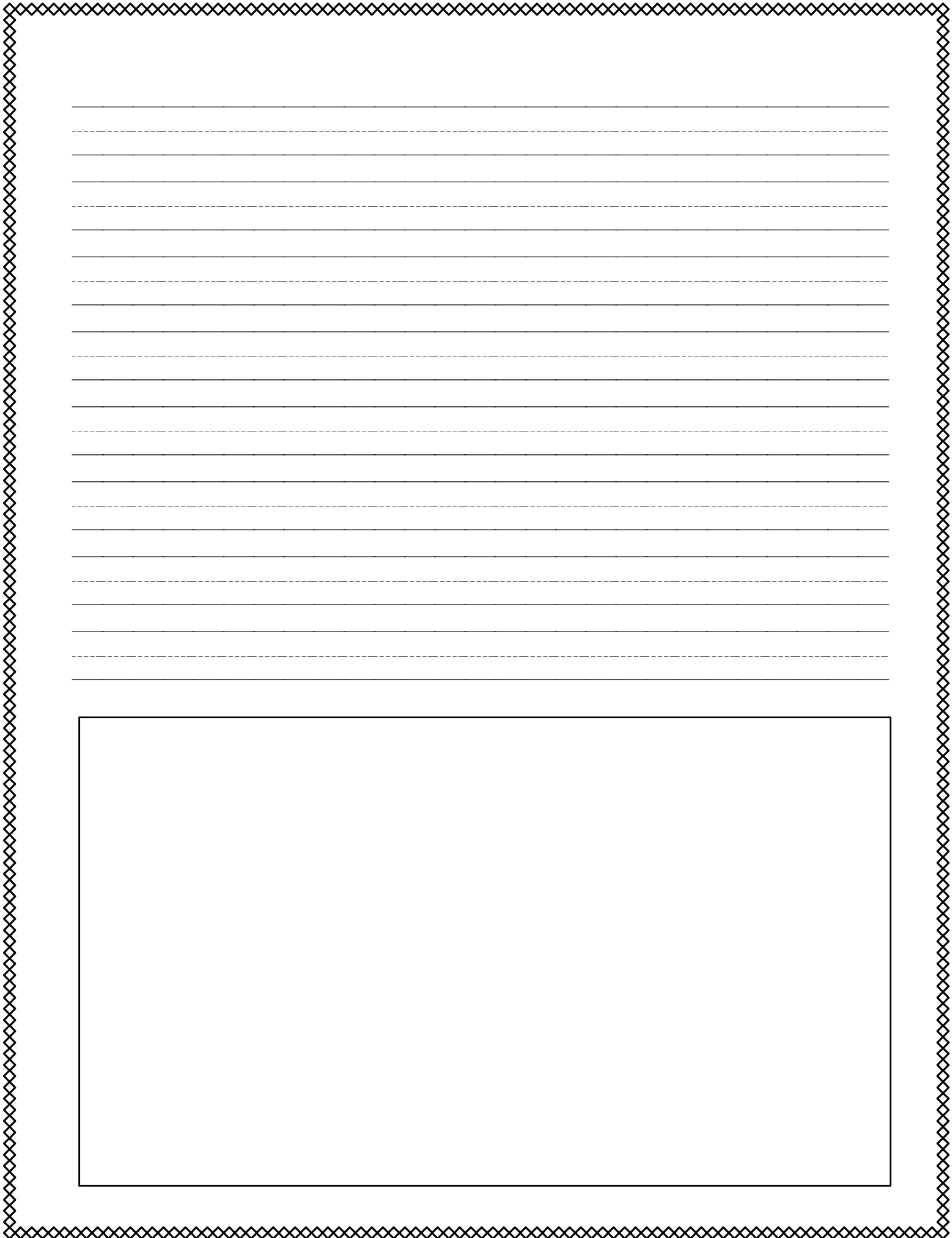
